- **Girl - age 4-7 (2 classes should do this group, higher # of patients this age.)**Any mani/pedi kits, pillow pets, comfy lap throws, fun games, crafts (i.e. bracelet kits, necklace kits), lava lamps, do rags, hats, soft head bands, paper jams microphones
- **Girl - age 8-11:** mani/pedi kits, pillow pets, throws, crafts, crafts, crafts, lava lamps, do rags, hats, games, frames that can be signed, pillow cases that can be signed, fun jewelry (bracelets and necklaces that say "Hope" possibly), paper jams microphones, Nintendo 3DS games
- **Girl - age 12-14:** mani/pedi kits, pillow pets, throws, crafts, lava lamps, hats, head bands, games, frames (maybe the kind you can sign), fun jewelry, iTunes gift cards, paper jams microphones
- **Girl - age 15-18:** iTunes gift cards, plush pillows, throws, hats, games, frames, jewelry,
- **Boy - age 0-3:** Soothing sounds toys, any light up toys, night lights that light up ceiling, teething toys, cool hats, PJs, little huggy blankets, Play-doh, trucks and cars,
